- COMPACT 2020 – Drug Prevention, Education and Enforcement (SCDTF)
- County Commission, Sheriff, District Attorney, Alabaster, Pelham, Chelsea, Hoover, Montevallo and Helena = 6 of 7 Municipalities (5K Population +)
- Shelby 911 in 1988 with First Dispatched Call on October 6, 1990
- Fire/EMS = 29 Entities Law Enforcement = 3 Cities & County Sheriff's Office

- Oak Mountain State Park Capital Improvement Projects & Tourism Initiatives  
Initially the County and State/DCNR + Grants and then Non-Profits + City on Specific Projects + Private Donors
- Cahaba River Park - Helena/Hoover North Sector & Boothton/Montevallo South Sector  
County + Private Landowner to State / Forever Wild Board / DCNR + State/Federal Grants

## Public Services, Facilities or Initiatives Accomplished through Partnering with Others

- Quality of Life Enrichment Grants – FY2003 - 2009 = 92 Projects = County \$530,145 of \$1,100,100
- Park & Recreation Grants - FY1996-2009: 161 Projects = County \$3.877M securing \$14,126,879
- Ambassador Grants - FY 1996-2009: 98 Projects = County \$114,690 securing \$1,163,874
- 25 Major Park Projects and Trail or Greenway Projects
- National Computer Forensic Institute - Hoover, State, County, Secret Service/Federal, State DA Association
- Community Storm Shelters
- Community of Hope Health Clinic 2009 located within the Health Department Building in Pelham
- Day Program – New Facility within New Alabaster YMCA off of Hwy 119
- Cahaba Wildlife Public Firing Range Complex (Helena Area Facility)
- New Health Services Building in Pelham for Health Department & Chilton Shelby Mental Health
- ClasTran – New Transportation Services Entity with capability to transport between Shelby & Jefferson

  - Assist Elderly family members with completing the online form
  - Assistance is also available at our local libraries
  - The personal information is confidential
- Each person counted in Alabama represents \$1,600 annually of federal funding (8 Billion State-wide)
  - 15 Federal Funding Sources Impacted – 5 Examples = Road & Bridge Funding, Clastran, Medicare, School Lunch Programs, Medicaid
  - County 215,707 (2018 Population Estimate) (\$1,600) = 345,131,200
- Alabama Congressional Seat at-risk
- 2010 Census – 80% Participation Rate - Shelby County Tied for Highest Participation Rate in Alabama
- 2020 Census Goal – 90%
